- Round Table on Trends, Issues & Challenges
 - Kristina-City of Lethbridge- extreme temperatures protocol has been activated. See link for more information: Winter weather triggers City's Extreme Weather Response Protocols | City of Lethbridge. ICAP table will no longer be facilitated at the City of Lethbridge, rather now Lethbridge Housing Authority is facilitating. https://www.lethbridgehousing.ca/coordinated-access-round-table.  - Denise-Family Centre- Jan 18th → support group for parents raising neurodiverse children, partnering with Family Ties and Autism AB. Once up and running it will go to every 34d Thursday. Also on Jan 18th will be a group for those who are going through separation/divorce. Lots of programs being run and can be found on the website. Building at building the caregiver connections.
 - Chevie-Lee-Shelter- with the weather getting so cold a lot of people are coming inside to seek warmth and looking for housing supports. Ongoing winter and clothing drive, accepted at the doors (underwear, leggings, base layers, sweatpants, snowpants, wind breaker pants, long/short sleeve shirts, emergency blankets, winter accessories, blankets but not sleeping bags, feminine hygiene products.). Always accepting organizations to come in and provide presentations or activities, especially with it being so cold. The drop-in center is up and running. Seeing a trend in individuals that seek treatment, detox and have no where to go after and end up falling back into the addiction. Outreach team are seeing an increase in youth that are homeless in the downtown area.
 - David-CHMA- dot operating reduced hours from 7am-7pm 7 days a week, with only one team. All other programs operating as normal.
 - Vicki-Building Brains- program planned as part of research study at NordBridge looking at senior executive functioning. Lethbridge Housing Outdoor Play pop ups start next week. Have a few events this month at community connections and disability resource fair.
 - Maritza- lost one of our systems navigators. Have some practicum students from the Social Work program start this week. Miranda will be leaving in February for maternity leave and Maritza will be the main contact. We offer support services for all ages, however, the counsellor only see's clients 15 years and up but can receive support while they wait for a counsellor from a system navigator.
 - Amy- be fast friends event, this is speed finding for friendship for seniors. Seeing a trend regarding increase in housing challenges for seniors and increase in homelessness; higher levels of addictions and complex mental health.







- Sam- have had some staff changeover in December. Programs resuming in the next couple of weeks.
- Deeanna-District 51- waiting on what is occurring on bussing for tomorrow and will update the public once the information is received. If families that have students in Lethbridge District 51, there is support for winter clothing and emergency food hampers. A lot of referrals regarding support, some long standing for housing and economics.
