We are here to increase your understanding of *your rights*, to assist you in understanding your obligations and to assist you in accessing services.

Navigating the justice system around experiences of sexual violence can be difficult and triggering. The process is different from those of other crimes and can be overwhelming because it is so complex. We will ensure that you have the information you need to decide whether to report and to provide you with consistent specialized supports throughout the court process and after.

The CSAC is dedicated to being a space where individuals can prioritize self-identified needs. We will listen to your unique experiences and needs while you are considering or navigating criminal justice options.
