A referral form and Proof of Guardianship (if applicable) are required for CAPPC.

WHO DO I NEED TO TALK TO?

If you call, you will ask to be connected with the Coordinator of CAPCC.


During this phone call you can expect an explanation of the service and whether the individual is experience isolation and is interested in reducing their isolation.

Typically you are able to access the program/service within within a week. There is a waiting period for accessing this service/program.
