Parents & caregivers, children, youth, and individuals can access classes.

WHO DO I NEED TO TALK TO?

If you call, you can talk to the Kitchen Coordinator for information about classes.

WHAT I SHOULD KNOW ABOUT THE PROGRAM/SERVICE

This program/service provides a community kitchen program that is open adults, families, youth and children. All cooking classes are in person. There are no costs to attend. Child care provided for young children while caregivers are in class. Participants take home two dishes that will serve four people.

Typically you are able to access the Kitchen Coordinator immediately or within 2 days.

Call the Kitchen Coordinator to register for adult cooking classes and for information on programming. Register online for child and youth cooking classes. There is a registration form to complete.
