- Early Development Scores identified children in Lethbridge as scoring below Alberta norms and Alberta's children as scoring below Canadian norms.
- Adopted a curriculum of activities that aimed to improve children's executive function skills.
- Offer free online courses at Building Brains website for clients and/or professional development.
- Curriculum is play-based activities and is free online under "resources" tab. Offer curriculum in Blackfoot and for children and adolescents.

- Early stages of creating a senior curriculum. A working group will be created to gather information to understand target audience.
